Step Two Receive & Approve Quote

The team will put together a comprehensive and detailed quote. The quote will outline a detailed scope of works, all inclusions and exclusions, along with the next steps, so there will be no surprises that pop up later.

Once quote is approved a deposit will get us startedsecuring materials and locking in your schedule



Step Three Receive Shop Drawings

Step Four Production Begins

Your windows and doors go into full production. All hardware, glass is ordered, delivered and fabricated locally right here in Melbourne.

Step Five Installation

Depending on your order your doors and windows could be dropped off at site a day or two before install day.
